MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: 9:00 BY Andrew Jones

OLD BUSINESS: Workstream updates were presented by attendees. Discussion followed regarding preparation of the community for wildfires. Andrew presented handouts prepared by KCFD following wildfires with successful outcomes. Community preparation, the ability to shelter in place, and coordination between KCFD and community were the focus of these publications.

There was a brief discussion of the recent POST fire, it's outcomes, and what we could have done to be more prepared as a community. Fire Safe Council is implementing a new program (HIZ) to promote home safety, hardening, and preparation for wildfires.

Among future plans discussed was our community ability to shelter in place. We do not currently have an establishment within the community that offers the opportunity, so the committee has made this a priority among our future wildfire preparations.
