Rule Article 20 (Election Rules)

Discussion: The board chair provided background and recommendations. The election rules have been written by general counsel. The committee had no recommendations for changes. The GM had no recommendations for changes to **BPP A-15** (Election Policy and Procedures).

Rule Article 21 (Environmental Control Code)

Discussion: The chair, board chair, environmental control officer, and patrol chief Patrice Stimpson provided recommendations. Topics discussed included vehicles, destroyed structures, temporary occupancy, Association property, nuisance and noxious activities, illegal marijuana cultivation, cottage industries, enforcement (moved to new business policy), and the list of definitions.

Action item: littering provisions in PMCPOA governing documents

Discussion: The chair presented findings on the various provisions mentioning littering and vandalism in the governing documents. By consensus the committee agreed to place a single common sentence in each provision. The affected provisions will be on future agendas for committee approval.

Business Policy x-xx (Environmental Control)

Discussion: The chair presented a draft of a new policy to contain the sections of the existing environmental control that are not by definition rules. The sections include the purpose and policy rewritten and the following procedures: authority and duties (of the ECC and the ECO), hearings on prospective building projects by members, committee recommendations, and due process and enforcement of the EC Code.
