Stable Hand/Ranch Maintenance Worker

- Feeding all horses morning and evening
- Daily cleaning of stalls/check horses
- Daily cleaning of pastures-limits
- Starting a vet schedule for all boarders
- Monitor the horses throughout the day (especially in snow and rain)
- Trail maintenance
- Cleaning water tanks
- Reporting hazards or unsafe conditions
- General landscaping; planting grass, shrubbery, trees and flowers
- Fertilization of all plants (grass, trees, flowers, etc.)
- Clean and clear culverts, ditches and drains
- Weed abatement
- Maintenance work: Fix fences, water tanks, barns and sprinkler heads, construction, plumbing, welding, electrical and equipment operations

- Clean and maintain vehicles
